Superintendent Train the Trainer Course 'Investing the industry with control'

The module covers:

- How to conduct Threat Assessment
- How to harden your ships, identify and create safe room
- How to counter piracy by understanding their MO
- How to act during attack and what to expect
- How to communicate with naval forces and what to expect
- How to effectively manage a crisis

Course fee and conditions:

- USD 2,500 per superintendent at Hereford, UK
- Additional travel costs to be included if conducted anywhere in the world
- USD 1,000 for trainer mob/demob
- Course duration: 5 days
- Minimum attendance is 2 superintendents

Management Training Course

The module covers:

- How to manage all aspects of crisis such as: pirates and related parties, officers/crew, families, media, underwriters/ brokers, naval forces
- How to negotiate and what to expect
- How to handle the post hijacking situation

Course fee and conditions:

- USD 500 per person per day excluding travel expenses
- USD 1,000 for mob/ demob to anywhere in the world
- Course duration: The course intended for half the team 1-day and the reminder on the following day (including weekends)
- Minimum attendance is 5 and maximum 10 persons

Additional information

Training centres:

- Our courses are conducted at Hereford, UK.
- Alternatively, the training can be conducted at the world's most modern maritime training facility in Cork, Ireland, owned and operated by the National Maritime College of Ireland. This 5-year-old USD 100 million facility it includes 360 degree bridge simulators, specialised life boat, fire fighting training facilities and a training pool that simulates a range of different weather conditions.
