## Simple, smart and reliable

Designed to meet the specific needs of operators ashore, Fleet Web keeps you up-to-date with the latest real-time information and observations, at your convenience via the Internet, enabling you to keep an eye on your ships' status wherever you are.

Fleet Web is simple, smart and reliable. It offers:

- Access to your own/chartered ship's position and Captain's intended route, including:
  - *Immediate Fleet overview*: at-a-glance position of your vessels enables you to view intended routes, calculated ETA, dialogue between the marine meteorologist and the ship, and much more
  - *Weather*: See with your own eyes the weather conditions your ships encounter along their recommended/intended route; wind, sea, swell, sea current, air temperature, precipitation and air pressure. Weather forecasts for the next 10 days are updated twice daily and Master's reported data is automatically evaluated in combination with the latest forecasts and analysis
  - Ensure your ships are on the optimal track
  - *Customisable* Fleetweb 3.0 allows you to customise overview columns, giving you access to the data you need, when you need it
  - *Comparison graphs*: No need to check raw data to assess performance: we do it for you
  - *Fleet performance*: Effective graphs allow you to check the performance of vessels in your fleet, based on their latest speed and consumption analysis
- *OVA (Ongoing Voyage Analysis)*: This new Fleet Web feature enables you to access all information related to a specific voyage, with a simple click on a vessel. The visual voyage display includes weather analysis, general ship and voyage data, daily reports from the vessel and all communications from SMHI to the ship - all in one place
- *Alert system*: Intuitive graphic design immediately shows which vessels require attention due to changes in ETA, speed or consumption, and heavy weather likely to affect a vessel in the next three days if it does not change its course
- Problems can be identified and rectified in good time, allowing ships operators and managers to be pro-active, not reactive
- *Showroom mode*: Want a quick and complete overview of your fleet? Need to impress clients with charts showing your fleet's position constantly updated? Showroom mode gives you to access a full-screen world map, with all the features for your vessels. This ensures that ship operators are aware of local weather changes affecting their ships and the impacts on ETA and ship safety
