



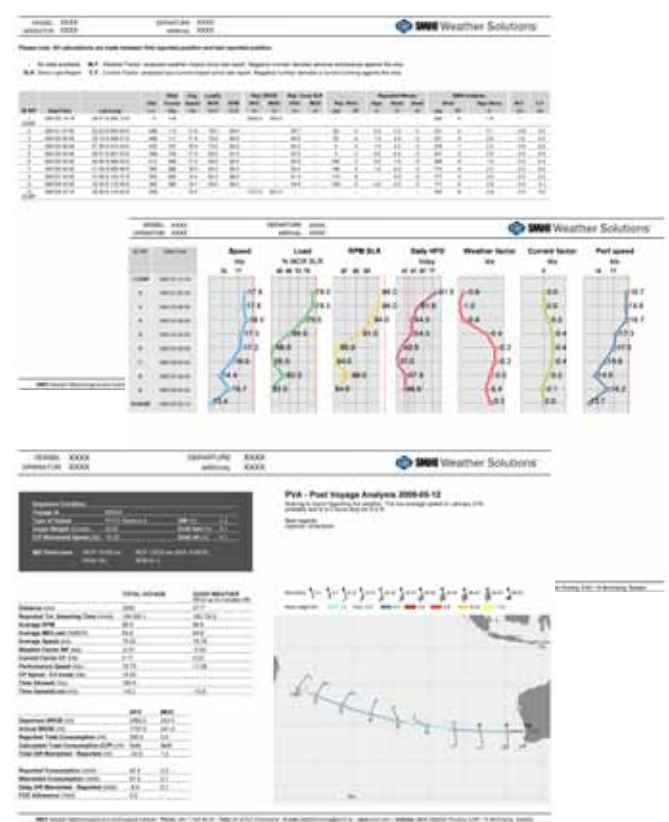

## Post Voyage Analysis

How did the voyage go? Did the ship perform as expected? The Post Voyage Analysis (PVA) service answers those questions, using the wind, wave and current database in combination with the Captain's report on his vessel's progress to make a reliable performance evaluation for owners, for those operating in a pool or charterers with T/C vessels.

Performance speed, weather and currents along the entire voyage and during "good weather" are the starting points. Calculation and presentation of over / underperformance or excessive bunker consumption is adjusted to the requirements of each individual customer.

A combination between PVA and Fleet Web is strongly recommended to achieve maximum results. PVA provides useful insights on the vessel's performance, while Fleet Web enables ship operators and managers to identify and rectify problems in good time. Being pro-active, not reactive, is the key to safe voyage. (See separate insertion on Fleet Web)
